High School Students Examine "World View"

The entire high school met with presenters from Multnomah University for a full day seminar featuring a multimedia presentation examining world views. Students had opportunity to consider the impacts of pre-modernism, modernism, and postmodernism. They also compared the philosophy or world view of each to Christianity and biblical world view. Students were asked how they can make a difference in the contemporary world. They were encouraged that they could do so by knowing the world - understanding culture, and by knowing the Word - understanding God's solutions to the problems of culture. They were exhorted to:

1. See the people around them.
2. Listen to them - ask questions and learn their story.
3. Identify with them. Share their personal story with them.
4. Share their life with them.
5. Share Jesus' love with them.
